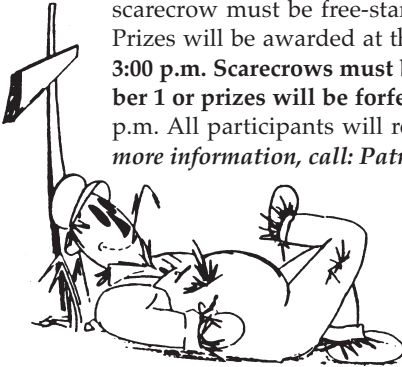


Design A Scarecrow Contest
